General Data Protection Regulations - Privacy Statement

Gravesend CC take privacy seriously and will only use your personal data for record purposes and on occasions to contact you to relay information relevant to club activity.

The only information we hold on you is:

Name – Address – Phone Numbers – email address – Membership Number as assigned by the club.

This information is collected by the club Chairman/Treasurer and recorded on a database by the club Secretary.

The data may be shared with club committee members for the purposes of administering competitions, relaying urgent information and on occasions circulating other information passed on to us by outside organisations. Where possible, emails will be sent BCC (Blind Carbon Copy) thus hiding your email address from other members.

We do not share your personal data with outside organisations and, if requested to do so, will always seek your permission beforehand.

The only exception will be if we are compelled to do so by law on any occasion.

Should you leave the club, your data will be held for a further 5 years for record purposes but you have the right to have this deleted immediately upon request.

With regards to the photographs you enter into GCC competitions, these will be seen by club members at internal competitions, when the title and author's name will be disclosed. The club may also use your images for external competitions and for promotional purposes without the club seeking further permission from you unless you state otherwise. Any of your photographs entered into external competitions, shown on the club's web site or used on any advertising or promotional literature will only disclose the author and title.
